Please note the following key dates as we transition from the current IACUC/ACORP supporting system in the Research Channel to the new IACUC supporting module in Cayuse....

Key Transition Dates associated with the IACUC process/platform:

October 1, 2025

- No new IACUC protocols/ACORPs will be accepted in the Research Channel effective October 1.
- Given that the deadline for new applications, amendments to existing applications, or requests for closeout of existing ACORPs, was prior to October 1, we do not anticipate interruptions to faculty, but in the event that some access or activity needs to be done, please reach out to the IACUC personnel (Drs. Valero or Jeske), and we will manage that manually and transition any activity manually to the new system.

October 2nd – 8th

- During this period, our IT professionals will complete the legacy data transfer from the Research Channel to Cayuse
- While no new applications or changes to existing Animal Oversight (IACUC) protocols will be accepted in the Research Channel during this transition window, if an urgent need arises, please reach out to Drs. Valero or Jeske. We will work with you to ensure no lapse in your needs to the best of our ability

Wednesday, October 16, 2025: Cayuse Go-Live

- All new Animal Oversight (IACUC) applications must be submitted through Cayuse
- The IACUC module in the Research Channel will become a “read-only” legacy system
- Amendments will be accepted immediately; renewal (known as “de novo” in Cayuse) applications will be required upon notification, prior to the 3-year anniversary of the most recent IACUC approval
