



Proof of Financial Support and Estimate of Expenses

AY 2026-2027

International students are required to submit financial documentation demonstrating that they have adequate funds to cover the total cost of attendance for one year of study in their academic program.

Students supported by their government, an educational institution, or official agency must submit an official letter reflecting that the scholarship is valid at Loyola University Chicago. The letter must contain the name of the scholarship and the amount being provided.

Students who will be self-supporting AND/OR will be supported by family funds need to submit a signed Affidavit of Support and provide proof of funding dated within the last six months and reflecting a balance availability to cover the total amount listed as well as the expenses of any dependents you are bringing with.

Note: In order to place an e-signature on the Affidavit of Support Form, please download, save to your desktop, and reopen the PDF form.

Please see below for estimated tuition, fee, and living expense figures. If a spouse or child will travel to the U.S. with you, you must provide an additional \$5,400 USD in funding (\$600/month) for each dependent.

Examples of acceptable financial documentation include, but are not limited to:

- Bank statements or letters
- Loan approval documents
- Scholarship letters
- Financial award letters
- Financial guarantees from home governments

All documentation you submit must:

- Clearly reflect the name of the account holder or issuer of the letter
- Have an Affidavit of Support letter if the account holder is not the student
- Be dated within six months
- Reflect funds available for immediate withdrawal, such as a checking or savings accounts. Investment, mortgage, line of credit documents will not be accepted.
- Be written in or professionally translated into English
- Clearly reflect the monetary denomination of funds (USD not required)
