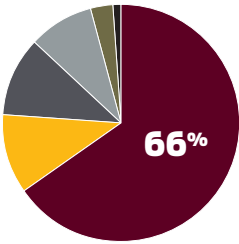

Employment Information for 2024 Graduates

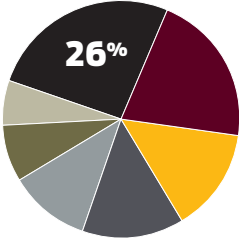
EMPLOYED BY JOB TYPE*
