## Accepting Applications for Co-Editors-in-Chief!

### Responsibilities:

- Hiring and managing volunteer editorial board members
- Maintaining social media accounts
- Building collaborations with faculty, staff, and student organizations in the School of Social Work
- Attending New Student Convocation, student organization fairs, and student panels upon invitation by the School of Social Work
- Conducting the formal submission and editorial process, including making final decisions to accept or reject manuscript submissions
- Facilitate editorial training for new editors
- Meet with faculty advisor, Co-Editor-in-Chief, and Production Editor to execute the journal
- Time Commitment:
  - Depends on editing cycle; some weeks require 10 plus hours, while other weeks require less than 2 hours

### Qualifications:

- Be available for flexible training to begin in upon finalizing the positions of co-editors-in-chief
- Be prepared to start executing the next Volume of Praxis in Fall 2025
- Currently pursuing a degree in the School of Social Work
- Able to commit to a full calendar year

- Receives one \$1500 tuition scholarship deposited directly to your university account
