### **Administrative History**

The Legion of Young Polish Women (Legion Młodych Polek or LMP) was founded in Chicago by Helen Lenard Pieklo and Adele Preyss (who became the organization's first president) on September 2, 1939 along with a group of 14-16 charter members. Founded as a non-profit organization in response to the German invasion of Poland on September 1, 1939, the Legion

sought to provide assistance to the people of Poland during World War II. After the war ended, the Legion continued to provide support to Poles in Poland, the United States, and around the world.

In Poland, the Legion maintained a tradition of assistance, supporting medical institutions, universities, and homes for children and the elderly. The Legion supported the Solidarity Movement during the 1980s, providing financial aid for the purchase of food, clothing, and medicine. Its “Medical Supplies to Poland” Project in the 1980s and 1990s provided over \$88,000 in assistance to small Polish clinics.

In the United States, the Legion helps ensure that Polish culture, heritage, and traditions retain a strong presence within the Polish American community. In 1961, the Legion helped to establish the professorship of Polish Language and Literature at the University of Chicago and in recent years has supported the Loyola University Chicago Polish Studies Program. The Legion supports the Polish Museum of America, Polish American arts organizations, Polish language schools, and many scholarship funds. The needs of new immigrants from Poland are addressed through assistance to the Polish American Association and the Polish American Congress Charitable Foundation. The Legion’s concerns reach out beyond its ethnic scope, as evidenced by donations to the Little Brothers-Friends of the Elderly the Special Olympics, Ronald McDonald House, and the Salvation Army.

Over the 75 years of the Legion’s existence, the organization has funded over \$1,400,000.00 of charitable and cultural projects in Chicago, the United States, Poland, and everywhere in the world where there has been a need to aid Poles and promote Polish culture.

The Legion’s main fundraising event, the annual White and Red Ball, has been a major social event of Chicago’s Polish community since it was first held in 1940. The iconic Presentation of Debutantes was added to the ball in 1945 and has continues to be a rite of passage for young Polish women in and around Chicago to this day.

## **Scope and Content**

The Legion of Young Polish Women Records consists of 102 linear feet of materials spanning the years 1939-2014, with the bulk of materials from approximately 1980-2007. Records contain correspondence, meeting minutes, ledgers, financial documents, reports, event information, newspapers, many photographs and scrapbooks, as well as some audiovisual and 3-D objects. Many individual records are written in Polish; series containing documents in Polish are noted below and individual folders containing records in Polish are marked. All series are arranged alphabetically and subsequently by date, where applicable, unless otherwise noted.

### **Series 1: Administrative Materials, 1939-2012, undated, Boxes 1-6**

This series contains awards and certificates, constitutions, articles of incorporation, histories, logos and stationery, meeting minutes and meeting attendance notebooks, membership and officer lists, committee reports, and administrative documents related to the Copernicus Foundation. Series contains documents that are in English and Polish.

#### **Subseries 1.1: Awards and Certificates, 1940, 1966-2003, undated, Box 1**

Contains certificates and awards presented to the Legion of Young Polish Women; documents are in both Polish and English. Additional oversized and framed certificates, as well as plaques and trophies, can be found in Series 8.

**Subseries 1.2: Copernicus Foundation, 1982-2002, undated, Box 1**

Consists of administrative materials related to the Copernicus Foundation and includes meeting minutes & agendas, reports, financial statements, and the rental agreement between the Legion of Young Polish Women and the Copernicus Foundation.

**Subseries 1.3: Governing Documents, 1939-2008, Box 1**

Contains constitutions & by-laws, proposed revisions to these documents, and official copies of the articles of incorporation.

**Subseries 1.4: Histories, 1939-1994, undated, Box 1**

Contains documents outlining the history of the Legion of Young Polish Women as well as a pamphlet created by the Polish American Historical Society in 1939 titled "What Happened with Poland;" subseries contains one document written in Polish.

**Subseries 1.5: Logos, 2008-2012, undated, Box 1**

Contains letterhead & envelopes, patent and trademark materials, and sketches (with labels in Polish).

**Subseries 1.6: Meeting Minutes & Attendance, 1948-1949, 1970-2012, undated, Boxes 1-4**

Includes board meeting and general meeting minutes as well as notebooks containing meeting minutes and meeting attendance lists.

**Subseries 1.7: Membership, 1939, 1965-2013, undated, Boxes 4-5**

Includes membership applications and registration forms, membership lists and directories, membership cards, suspensions, and information about individual members (some of which is in Polish). Additional digital content pertaining to individual member Eugenia Miczko is available.

**Subseries 1.8: Officers & Committees, 1939-2007, undated, Boxes 5-6**

Contains lists of officers and committee members, reports from officers and committees, inventories completed by the outgoing President, and officer manuals. Materials in this subseries are in both English and Polish.

**Series 2: Correspondence, 1939-2013, undated, Boxes 6-24**

Consists of correspondence both to and from the Legion; the bulk of which relates to requests for financial assistance. Because original order has been maintained whenever possible, correspondence can also be found in Series 3 (financial correspondence) and Series 5 (event specific correspondence). The majority of the folders in this series contain correspondence in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 2.1: General Correspondence, 1939-2009, undated, Boxes 6-24**

The larger of the two subseries, the correspondence in this subseries are arranged chronologically. The original order of the correspondence has been maintained wherever possible. This has led to a slight difference in the organization of individual folders within this subseries. Some folders represent correspondence reviewed at specific monthly meetings (as indicated in the folder title) while others consist of correspondence written in a given period. Most folders contain materials in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 2.2: Topical Correspondence, 1981-2013, undated, Box 24**

The correspondence in this subseries was originally organized by subject, rather than date, and this organizational structure has been maintained. Folders are arranged topically in alphabetical order.

**Series 3: Financials, 1939-2009, undated, Boxes 24-31**

Contains information related to LMP financials. Documents include financial correspondence, bank and account information, donation records, dues information, ledger books, treasurer reports, reports and receipts related to events, and tax documents.

**Subseries 3.1: Banks & Accounts, 1977-2008, undated, Box 24**

This subseries contains documents related to various banks and accounts used by the Legion including correspondence, account applications, account tax statements, contracts, bond schedules, account booklets and statements, and safety deposit box inventories.

**Subseries 3.2: Donations, 1939, 1943, 1978-1997, undated, Box 24**

Subseries contains various kinds of materials recording donations made by the Legion to other organizations.

**Subseries 3.3: Dues Information, 1987-2007, undated, Boxes 24-25**

Subseries includes lists, notebooks, and receipt books noting members who have paid their dues as well as lists of members who have not paid dues.

**Subseries 3.4: Event Financials, 1939-2009, undated, Boxes 25-27**

Materials in this subseries relate to events held by the Legion of Young Polish Women. Documents here include receipts, reports, invoices, and bills. One-time events, such as picnics, fashion shows, and benefit concerts are represented as well as reoccurring annual events such as the Swietojanki picnic and the White and Red Ball. Because original order was maintained whenever possible, financial information about the Swietojanki picnic, the White and Red Ball, and various anniversary celebrations can be found in Series 5 as well. This subseries contains documents in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 3.5: General Bills & Expenses, 1980-1981, 2000-2009, undated, Box 27**

Subseries contains bills, notes, reports, and invoices for general expenses not associated with specific events. These expenses include printing costs, rent, insurance, refreshments for meetings, tickets to events held by other organizations, and office supplies.

**Subseries 3.6: Ledgers, 1939-1943, 1978-2003, undated, Boxes 27-29**

Subseries contains ledger books and sheets kept by the treasurer documenting income, expenses, dues, and other financial information. Materials within this subseries are arranged chronologically.

**Subseries 3.7: Tax Documents, 1939-2004, Box 30**

This subseries contains all tax related documents including annual reports, income tax returns, correspondence, tax exemption applications, and tax preparation materials.

**Subseries 3.8: Treasurer's Reports, 1941-2009, undated, Boxes 30-31**

Materials within this subseries include audits, reports, and report notebooks, created by the treasurer. This subseries contains some documents which are written only in Polish.

**Series 4: Publications, 1939-2007, undated, Boxes 31-35**

This series contains published materials created by the Legion as well as by outside organizations. Materials include newsletters, books, newspapers, newspaper clippings, pamphlets, brochures, magazines, booklets, and annual reports. This series contains documents written in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 4.1: Legion Publications, 1977, 1993-1995, undated, Box 31**

Contains two copies of *Kosciuszko Letters in the American Revolution*, a book published by the Polish Museum of America with the aid of the Legion of Young Polish Women, as well as Legion newsletters.

**Subseries 4.2: Newspapers & Newspaper Clippings, 1939-2003, undated, Boxes 31-32**

This subseries contains copies of Polish language newspapers, newspaper clippings about LMP events from English and Polish newspapers, and other clippings saved by members of the Legion. Because original order has been maintained wherever possible, newspaper articles about specific events and activities can also be found in Series 5. Newspapers and newspaper clippings in this subseries are written in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 4.3: Outside Publications, 1966-2007, undated, Boxes 32-35**

This subseries contains materials published by outside organizations or individuals and sent to the Legion of Young Polish Women. The majority of the organizations represented are Polish American organizations but also include non-Polish organizations that worked with or received support from the Legion. Materials include books, pamphlets, booklets, newsletters, brochures, magazines, and annual reports. Folders are arranged alphabetically by affiliated organization (where possible) or by the title of the publication. This subseries contains documents written in both English and Polish.

**Series 5: Activities, 1939-2014, undated, Boxes 35-61**

Documents in this series pertain to Legion activities and events as well as the activities and events of related organizations attended by Legion members. Materials include invitations, scholarship applications, reports, event programs, correspondence, financial documents, and newspaper clippings. Documents are in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 5.1: Causes, 1940, 1961-2011, undated, Box 35**

Subseries contains information related to various causes championed by the Legion including sending Ambulances to Poland during WWII, various scholarship funds, relief efforts, and the Polish Language Chair at the University of Chicago. Types of materials include invitations, scholarship applications, lists of scholarship recipients, project proposals, programs, correspondence, and newspaper clippings. Documents in this subseries are written in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 5.2: General Events, 1939-2009, undated, Boxes 35-39**

This subseries consists of materials related to Legion events and includes items such as reports, correspondence, financials, invitations, programs, flyers, and raffle tickets. Additional financial information for individual events can also be found in Subseries 3.4: Event Financials. Binders related to individual events were deconstructed and their contents were transferred to folders; original order was maintained during this process. Documents related to the annual White and Red Ball can be found in Subseries 5.5: White and Red Ball. This subseries contains materials written in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 5.3: Medical Supplies to Poland, 1987-1996, undated, Boxes 39-42**

This subseries contains materials related to the Legion's project to send medical supplies to clinics in Poland. Materials include reports, lists of items shipped, shipping invoices, receipts, letters of acknowledgement and thank you notes. Much of the material in this subseries was originally organized in binders for each shipment, which were rehoused with the original order maintained. The majority of the materials in this subseries are written in Polish, but all reports are in English.

**Subseries 5.4: Outside Organizations, 1965-2007, undated, Boxes 42-45**

Subseries contains documents that pertain to activities and events from other (mainly in Polish) organizations that were either attended or supported by the Legion. Materials include programs, invitations, brochures, correspondence, and flyers. Documents in this subseries are written in English and Polish.

**Subseries 5.5: White and Red Ball, 1940-2014, undated, Boxes 45-61**

Materials in this subseries relate to the Legion's annual White and Red Ball and include reports, program books, guidelines, invitations, correspondence, newspaper articles, financial statements, and invoices. Binders devoted to each White and Red Ball were deconstructed, and their contents were transferred to folders; original order was maintained during this transfer. Items are arranged alphabetically by topic, with documents related to individual balls arranged chronologically. This subseries contains material in both English and Polish.

**Series 6: Photographs, 1940-2011, undated, Boxes 61-70, Flat File**

This series contains photographs of Legion-sponsored events and activities as well as the events of other organizations that were attended by LMP members. Identification information for photographs is in both English and Polish.

**Subseries 6.1: General, 1940-2005, Boxes 61-62**

Includes photographs of various individuals, groups, events, and celebrations.

**Subseries 6.2: White and Red Ball, 1951-2009, undated, Box 63-64, Flat File**

Subseries contains professional and personal photographs from the annual White & Red Ball, ball publicity photos, and photos from the debutante teas. Subseries contains identification information for photographs in both English and Polish. Additional photographs were donated to the archives in a digital format. Digital content includes White & Red Ball 2014 photographs.

**Subseries 6.3: Photo Albums, 1949-1997, undated, Boxes 43-70**

This subseries contains photographs originally held in photo albums. Photographs were removed from albums for preservation and original order was maintained as much as possible. Subseries contains photographs of events such as White and Red Balls, Debutante Teas, SwietoJanki festival, and Anniversary Balls as well as albums created by specific individuals. Folders are labeled by the name of the album (where applicable) or a description of its contents.

**Series 7: Audiovisual Materials, 1972, 1987-2013, undated, Boxes 70-77**

Contents of this series include audiocassette tapes, electronic discs, 16mm films, VHS tapes, and U-matic/U-matic S video tapes. Items arranged chronologically by format.

**Subseries 7.1: Audiocassette Tapes, 1993, Box 70**

Subseries contains one audiocassette tape labeled "LMP March," which includes the White and Red Ball Debutante march by William A. Kroll (as stated on the recording). This tape was digitized by Midwest Productions in November 2025.

**Subseries 7.2: Electronic Discs, 2009-2013, Box 70**

Subseries contains DVDs and CDs of White and Red Balls.

**Subseries 7.3: Films, circa 1962, 1972, Boxes 71-72**

Subseries contains two 16mm moving image films of White and Red Balls, which were digitized by Midwest Productions in November 2025. The film circa 1962 is in black & white with no sound. The 1972 White and Red Ball was hosted by actor Bob Lewandowski, and the film is in color with sound.

**Subseries 7.4: Interviews, 2014, Digital Only**

This subseries contains digital audio files and transcripts for interviews with Legion members and supporters conducted by Laura Pearce, WLA graduate assistant, in July and August of 2014. These interviews were conducted in conjunction with the creation of the Legion of Young Polish Women 75th Anniversary digital exhibit. See archivist for access to the digital files. 1989-1990), Alexandra Ciesla Cornwell (Legion member; 1998 debutante), Lucille Gutowski (Legion member since, President 2007-2008), Anthony Kawalkowski (longtime friend of the Legion and orchestra director for the White & Red Ball), Jane Kobos (Legion member), Lara Boris Kuechel (Legion member, 1985 debutante), Kathy Lesny (Legion member, 2006 debutante), Conrad Miczko (son of longtime member Eugenia Miczko, considerable knowledge of the Legion's founding and early years), Richard Oswiany (longtime friend of the Legion, choreography director for the White & Red Ball since 1990), Barbara Poniatowska-Ciepiela (Legion member, benefited from Legion aid during WWII when she was a child in an army camp in North Africa, held many leadership positions including President 2003-2004), Aurelia Pucinski (Justice, Illinois Appellate Court, 1st District; Legion member; previously served as Mistress of Ceremonies for the White & Red Ball), Emily Rafalik (Legion member, 2014 debutante), Magda Szala (Legion member, 2014 debutante).

**Subseries 7.5: VHS Tapes, 1987, 2001-2004, Boxes 73**

Subseries contains videocassettes (VHS) of event footage from the Swietojanki picnic in 1987 and from a number of White & Red Balls. The Swietojanki footage from 1987 was digitized by Midwest Productions in 2024. Additional items were digitized by Midwest Productions in November 2025. Specific digitized items are identified in the container list below.

**Subseries 7.6: Videocassette Tape Masters, 1987-1992, Boxes 73-77**

Subseries contains videocassette tape masters (U-matic/U-matic S) footage from a number of White & Red Balls as well as Swietojanki picnics, and LMP History. The LMP History Broadcast Master Tapes originally created in 1988 were sent to Cinemalab Preservation (Englewood, CO) for digitization in July 2014. Tapes consist of interviews with Legion members conducted in English and Polish between May and October of 1988. See below for individuals interviewed on each tape. St. John's Festival-Swietojanki tapes were digitized by Midwest Productions in 2024. Tapes for the White & Red Ball in 1989, 1990, and 1992 were digitized by Midwest Productions in November 2025. **Series 8: Scrapbooks, Oversize, and 3-D Material, 1939-2011, undated, Boxes 78-103, Flat File**

This series contains oversize documents and certificates as well as three-dimensional objects such as buttons, medallions, trophies, plaques, jewelry, and stamps. A number of scrapbooks are also included. This series contains materials written in English and Polish.

**Subseries 8.1: Oversize Documents and 3-D Materials, 1940-2011, undated, Boxes 78-89, Flat File**

Contents of this subseries include framed and oversized certificates, trophies, buttons, plaques, medallions, commemorative coins, jewelry, stamps, and a seal. Materials are arranged by general categories: plaques and framed certificates, trophies, and other items are arranged chronologically within each category. Certificates and plaques are written in English and Polish. Maria Ciesla, a former debutante and past president of the Legion, provided additional information about the following items on July 19, 2014:

Commemorative Ribbon with Medallion, 1969: "The mermaid indicates it is not official or from the Polish government. It might have represented an anniversary of the city of Warsaw, as mermaid is its symbol, or a gift from the AK Polish Army Veterans."

Rose Necklace, undated: "The rose pendants were not given to debs to my knowledge [the graduate student processing the records had hypothesized they might have been] but were given as a gift to Past presidents by President Raczynska at one of the anniversaries. Had to be in the '90s. I have mine."

**Subseries 8.2: Scrapbooks, 1939-2006, undated, Boxes 90-103**

This subseries contains scrapbooks and scrapbook binders. Many scrapbooks contain newspaper clippings, portions of event programs, invitations, and photographs. Most of the scrapbooks were created by members of the Legion of Young Polish Women, most notably by the historian, while a few were created by outside organizations and given to the Legion. Materials are arranged chronologically by date of contents. Contents of scrapbooks are in English and Polish.
