Administrative History

In order to establish a fundraising arm for Massachusetts Women-Church, Marie Sheehan, Sr. Claire O'Rourke and a number of Massachusetts women organized Lost Coin Women's Fund, Inc. (LCWF), a charitable organization. The mission of the organization is to provide grants to low-income Massachusetts women so they may attend an undergraduate institution or vocational training program. The organization was established in 1992 and has assisted hundreds of women in need since its inception.

Scope and Content

The Lost Coin Records consist of 0.25 linear feet (1 box) of materials and span the years 1992 – 2011. The contents relate to the group's administration from its establishment in 1992 and includes articles of incorporation, bylaws, 2010 Annual Report, policy and procedure manual, and website printout.
